- Stylus
- Well-worn graphite

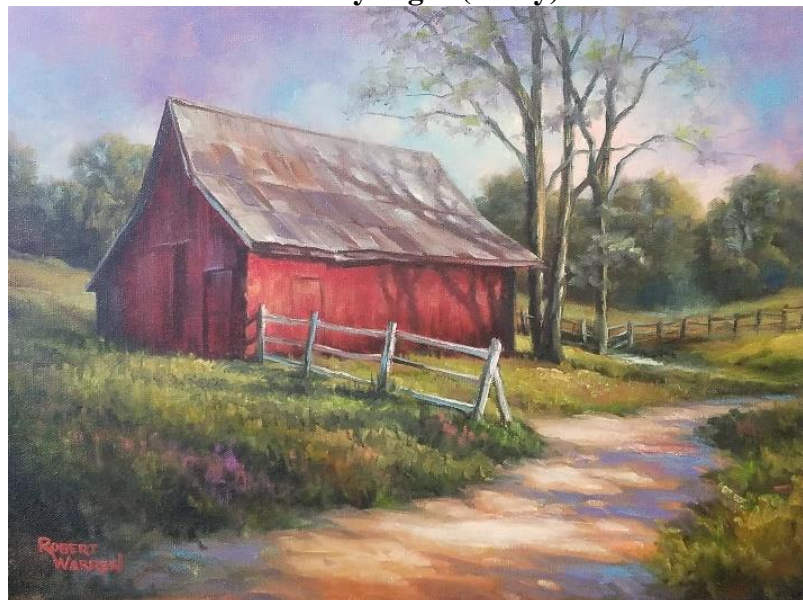
